

Receiving the Sheikhs of Bani Malek, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim: The Citizen Bloc Has Prepared for the Four Coming Years a Scientific Program to Manage Iraq and Provide for the Needs of a Decent Life

The head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, assured that the tribes have a major role in maintaining the Arab and Islamic identity, explaining that the tribe is an important pillar of the Iraqi society and that a strong tribe leads to a strong society and thus to a strong State.
