

Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Calls on the Network of Observers to Double Efforts In Order to Make the Observation Process Succeed



The head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, stressed the need for the early presence of observers in voting centers and for their stay until the end of the counting and sorting process.
