

## **In his Meeting with Mr. al-Amiri, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Says the National Alliance Is the Shelter We Seek and the Citizens' Coalition Works on Institutionalizing It**



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, stressed the importance of turning the national alliance into efficient institution, describing it as the shelter all its components seek and stressing the importance of taking advantage of the past experience.
