

In His Meeting with Al Khozaei, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Stressed the Need for a Partnership of Strong Parties that Would Reassure All Components



Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, clarified that the partnership of strong parties does not mean marginalizing the rest of the national parties but rather means representing the major forces of Iraqi components, the forces that has gained their trust.
