

In his Meeting with Al Karbouli, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Stresses the Importance of Unifying the National Position and Supporting Security Forces in their Fight Against Terrorism



Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, stressed the need to unify the national position regarding the challenges that Iraq is facing, mainly the terrorist attacks occurring in Iraqi provinces and cities, highlighting the importance of reinforcing the unity of the Iraqi people and put an end to everything that could dispel the unity and cohesion of the Iraqi components.

This came when Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim was receiving the Head of the Hal bloc, Jamal al-Karbouli, on Monday, June 9th, 2014 in his office in Baghdad.
