

Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Participates with the Volunteers in Responding to the Religious Authority's Call

Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, participated with the volunteers in responding to the authority's call, on Friday, June 13, 2014.
