## Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim: All Eyes Are Now on the National Alliance. They Must Make a Choice and Run a Candidate that Would Gain Wide Acceptance on the National Arena



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, said the eyes are now on the National Alliance, so they must make a choice and run a candidate that would gain wide acceptance among the Iraqi citizens and confirm his compliance with the instructions and recommendations of the supreme religious authority.
