

During a Visit to the Refugees Camps in Erbil, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Calls on the Government to Provide More Care to the Displaced and Relieve their Suffering

Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, called to increase the care provided to the persons who fled from regions hit by terrorist attacks and collective displacement, especially regions inhabited by minorities. This came during his eminence's visit to the displaced families of Shabak, Christians and Yazidis in churches, convents, schools, camps and temporary residencies in Erbil in the context of his visit to Kurdistan on Monday, September 22, 2014.
