

## **Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Calls on Kurd Ministers to Join their Ministries in Baghdad and Perform their National Duties in Building Iraq**

Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, met on the evening on Monday, September 22, 2014, the leaderships of the Patriotic Union of Kurdistan in the city of Sulaymaniyah to which his eminence arrived coming from Erbil.
