

Receiving a Delegation from the Provincial Council of Ninveveh, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Reiterates His Support to Nineveh and its People to Eliminate ISIS



Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, reiterated his support to the local government of Nineveh to free the province from the ISIS gangs, affirming his full support to granting the local governments their complete mandates and avoiding the mistakes of the past.
