

During a Meeting with a Delegation of the Leaders of Dulaym Tribes, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim: National Unity and Cohesion of the Iraqi People Will Make Iraq Stronger and Safe from Enemies' Conspiracies



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council, said the national unity through the communication between the tribes and their support for each other will make Iraq stronger and thus safe from the enemies' conspiracies and will stop the continuous Iraqi bloodshed.
