## During A Meeting With Yonadam Kanna, Head of The Christian al-Rafidayn National Coalition.... Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Calls For The Formation of A Higher Committee To Aid The Displaced And Address Their Problems



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, called for the formation of a higher committee to aid the displaced, address their problems and take care of them by providing them with the best services pertaining to the adequate housing, food and health care which are worthy of the Iraqi citizen.
