

In A Meeting with The Representative of UN Secretary-General, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Stresses the Need to Keep Weapons under the Exclusive Control of The Government and To Resist against the Organized Crime Gangs



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Iraqi Islamic Supreme Council, stressed the need to keep weapons under the exclusive control of the government, calling on the security forces to make extraordinary efforts to maintain security and to resist against the organized crime gangs.
