

During a Meeting with the Ambassador of Palestine, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Reiterates Iraqi's Support for the Palestinian People in their Defense for their Rights

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, reiterated Iraq's support for the Palestinian people in their defense for their violated rights, condemning the continuous Israeli transgressions against the Palestinian people, while emphasizing the love and brotherhood-based strong relationships between the Iraqi citizens and the Palestinian Diaspora in Iraq. On the other hand, he pointed out to the role of the religious authorities- since the marja Imam Mohsen al-Hakim until this date- in supporting and advocating the Palestinian cause since it is the Muslims' central cause.
