

During a Meeting with a Number of the Leaders of the Barzanji Tribes all Over Iraq, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Renews his Call for a Higher Council of Iraqi Tribes



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, renewed his call to create a higher council for the Iraqi tribes that would support them without controlling or blackmailing them, saying the tribes are a case that is more global than any party.

This came during a meeting held on Thursday, 5/2/2015, between his Eminence at his office in Baghdad and a number of the leaders of the Barzanji tribes all over Iraq from all components.
