Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Receives British Ambassador and Stresses the Need to Prevent Iraq's Enemies from Affecting Unity



Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, stressed the need for harmony among all Iraqi components and national forces, and highlighted the importance of preventing the enemies of Iraq from affecting its unity.
