During His Meeting with Turkish Ambassador, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim: The Security and Stability of Iraq Can Extend to the Entire Region



Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, stressed the importance of strengthening relations between Iraq and Turkey including in the area of fight against terrorism.
