

Presiding over the Enlarged Central Shura Meeting, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Says the National Reconciliation Is a Priority in this Stage and Requires Compromises from Both Parties



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, reiterated the need of Iraq for the national reconciliation since it is a priority in this stage, emphasizing the importance that everyone makes compromises to the others and tries to meet halfway, calling on the parties who blocked their activities and attendance in the Parliament and the Council of Ministers to resume their tasks in both councils. On the other hand, his Eminence praised the instructions of the religious authority to those who answered its call, considering it as a historical document representing a global vision of the good Jihad conduct, pointing to the importance of discussing the post-ISIS period and of embracing those who were tricked into joining the group and re-injecting the sense of patriotism in them, explaining the importance of implementing the governmental platform of the national unity government.

This came on Monday, 23/2/2015 during a meeting of the enlarged central Shura of the Martyr of the Niche movement presided over by his Eminence at his office in Baghdad.

His Eminence also talked about the security developments in the region and the expansion of ISIS activities in Libya and Egypt, explaining that such expansion is exactly the one his Eminence warned against and described as the malign tumor that will spread over as soon as the ground for it is ensured.

On the other hand, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim underlined the importance of discipline within the Martyr of the Niche movement , of prioritizing the public interests over the instantaneous ones and of sticking to the platform and introducing it to the public.
