

The Governor of Basra Informs Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim About the 2015 Province Plan and Affirms that Services are Its Essential Substance



Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, received in his office in Baghdad on Saturday, March 14, 2015, the governor of Basra Dr. Majid Al Nasrawi.

His eminence stressed the importance of serving the citizens of Basra and compensating the city for the atrocities of war and administrative confusion. He also highlighted that the citizens of Basra should enjoy the wealth of their city just like the rest of Iraq does, calling to implement the program of the citizen's coalition with available means.
