

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Discusses with the Director of the UNICEF Office in Iraq the Ways of Development of the Educational and Health Situation in Iraq

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, called on the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) to multiply its efforts to help improve the educational and health situation in Iraq, particularly for children, stressing the need for supporting Iraqi children and protecting their rights, especially in the liberated areas after the displaced families return to them.
