

During a Meeting with the Minister of Interior, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Stresses the Importance of the National Card Project and the Use of IT for the Administration of the Security Issue



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, stressed the importance of the national card since it cancels the four fundamentals that encumbered the Iraqi citizens, saying the national card is a transition from a monotonous routine case to a stage that reduces the load on the Iraqi citizens' shoulder, calling for extensively using the information technology for the administration of the security issue and the police since it is considered as a basic element in preparing a solid database.
